Financial Information

Application Fee: \$125 per new student K3-12th grade (non-refundable). The application fee must be paid when the application is submitted via the online portal.

Enrollment and Reenrollment Fee: \$100 per new enrolling student and reenrolling students in K3-12th grade (non-refundable). The fee is due when submitting the enrollment form via the online portal.

Tuition: Berean Baptist Academy does not charge fees for athletics, books, fine arts, standardized tests, learning management/technology systems, lab fees, or electives. Tuition covers a comprehensive educational opportunity for all students.

All accounts must be registered with the FACTS payment system. **Those who complete enrollment by March 15 and start school on the first day of the year will receive a 2% discount*.** Those who select a one-time payment will receive a 3% discount. Those who select one payment per semester will receive a 2% discount. Those on the 11-month payment plan will be billed on either the 5th or 20th of each month beginning in August through June.

- Preschool Morning: \$4,100 (\$372.73 monthly) (No Discounts)
- Preschool Day: \$5,200 (\$472.73 monthly) (No Discounts)
- Preschool Full Day: \$5,900 (\$536.37 monthly) (No Discounts)
- Elementary (K5-5th) \$5,200 (\$472.73 monthly) (Multi-child discounts available for
- Middle School (6th-8th) \$5,300 (\$481.82 monthly) K5 -12th Grade – 2nd Child (15%),
- High School (9th-12th) \$5,400 (\$490.91 monthly) 3rd Child (30%), 4th Child (50%))

International Student Tuition and Fees: Covers tuition and all costs associated with the international student program. The fee is \$9,500 for the academic program and \$6,000 host family stipend (paid directly by international agency to the host family). Students may pay in full or two payments of \$4,750.

Withdrawal Fee: When a student is withdrawn by the parents after completing enrollment and before the account is paid in full, there is a \$500 fee.

Summer Enrichment: Cost of courses will be determined by the length and nature of the course. A list of courses will be provided in the Spring. Study abroad opportunities will be announced in the fall. Courses for recovery may be offered in the Middle and Lower Schools. High School students will need to take recovery courses via online instruction during the next school year. Travel expenses for study abroad opportunities must be paid for by the student.

Extended Care: Covers the cost of student care before and/or after school.

<u>Annual Rate</u>	<u>Daily Rate – Per Student</u>
1 Child \$1,800	\$12 per morning or afternoon
2 Children \$2,400	\$15 per morning and afternoon
3 Children \$3,300	*Rates are applied when the student enters extended care.

Miscellaneous Fees: The following are billed through FACTS when applicable.

- School Lunch: \$5 (K5-12th); An additional entrée is \$2 each.
- Delinquent Payment: \$50
- Returned Check: \$30
- Kindergarten Graduation: \$100
- High School Graduation: \$150
- After-School Detention: \$12 per day
- Saturday Detention: \$40 per day
- In School Suspension: \$80 per day
- Holiday Care (K3-K4): \$40 per day
- Lost/Damaged Book: Cost of Replacement
- Transcript: \$5 (First Five Free to Currently Enrolled Seniors Only)
- Records Transfer: \$20 (First copy is free)

Students receiving the North Carolina Opportunity Scholarship should notify the Academy as soon as possible. Each family must present their award letter to the financial office. Families receiving the NCOS are not eligible for BBA financial assistance.
