KEEPING CAMPUS SAFE

How do we keep campus secure?

- Operate on a locked-campus policy
- Provide yearly training to staff and personnel on emergency procedures
- Conduct monthly fire drills
- Rotate code drills to train staff and students on emergency operations
- Utilize cameras throughout the building to monitor public spaces
- Require background checks for all employees and volunteers
- Maintain current CPR/First Aid certifications for staff



CODE DRILLS

Berean has a comprehensive Emergency Response Plan which is reviewed and updated annually. In addition to monthly fire drills, Berean regularly conducts safety drills to train students and staff in the event of an actual emergency.

Active Shooter - a complete lockdown on campus in the event of a known intruder or active threat on campus. Everyone is in a secured space with no visibility inside classrooms.

High Alert - a modified lockdown on campus with a heightened sense of awareness to one's surroundings on campus and no visibility inside classrooms.

Weather Threat - a weather or natural disaster such as a tornado or earthquake; students move to the most secure locations in respective buildings and away from glass.

Evacuation Drills - students evacuate the building in the event of fire or a bomb threat.
